IFSS WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS & WORLD MASTERS 2023

On-Snow

Åsarna, Sweden

February 26 – March 2, 2023

GENERAL:

1. Use of private motor vehicles on the trails is not allowed.
2. Participants may inspect the trail only on skis and without a dog.
3. Entries for IFSS members is via the IFSS Voting National Member and the Provisional Member federations only, using the official entry form.
4. Microchip identification for the dogs is mandatory. All dogs must be listed on the chipping form (one form per driver and per class). Only IFSS chipping forms are accepted.
5. Required vaccinations for all dogs, including dogs not racing: **Rabies, Distemper, Adenovirus-2 (Hepatitis and tracheo-bronchitis), Parvovirus and "Kennel cough" (Parainfluenza and Bordetella bronchiseptica).**

All vaccines must have been administered more than 21 days before the official day of opening of the stake-out (NOT the day when the dog starts to race!). Validity of vaccinations as stated in the dog's passport. To evaluate the validity of vaccinations ONLY the "dog passport" or the "dog vaccination booklet" will be taken in consideration. These documents must show for each vaccination the date of injection with the stamp and the signature of the veterinary who did it.

Note 1) Kennel cough vaccinations have to protect against BOTH Parainfluenza AND Bordetella bronchiseptica (as with INTRANASAL or INJECTABLE vaccines). Only if the dog is protected with an injectable vaccine against Parainfluenza given not longer than 1 year before (as in DHPPi vaccine), then the ORAL vaccine for Bordetella bronchiseptica is accepted.

Note 2) In addition to previous vaccinations Leptospirosis vaccination is not mandatory, but STRONGLY recommended.

Note 3) Rabies vaccination is mandatory also for dogs living in Sweden and Norway.

6. It is **strictly forbidden** during this event to allow dogs to run loose at the event site, stake-out area and event parking lots. Loose dogs are only permitted within personal containment areas (fenced area around participant's vehicle) in the designated stake-out area. Refusal to respect this requirement may lead to disqualification from the event.

7. Each competitor and national team are responsible for the action of his/her handlers.
8. All participating nations shall appoint one team leader. The team leaders name, phone number and email address shall be noted on the entry forms. Team leaders shall be present at the team leader meetings. In view of their liaison task between the race organizer and their team members, they shall speak English.

Sp4MS seeding will be made based on the Sp4 final results.

Mid-Distance classes will have following pools:

- MD6 with a pool of 8 dogs maximum (first heat shall consist of 6 dogs and the following heats of 5-6 dogs).
- MD12 with a pool of 14 dogs maximum (first heat shall consist of 10-12 dogs and the following heats of 8-12 dogs).
- MDSM and MDSW – no pool (all heats shall consist of minimum 1 dog, maximum 2 dogs).

As stated in the IFSS Championships Regulations (approved by the IFSS Member Federations at the GA 2022):

- World Champion titles shall be awarded to the best (fastest) teams of each rated class of the World Championships provided that at least ten (10) competitors from five (5) countries are represented in these classes, except in junior classes where at least three (3) competitors from two (2) countries are represented.
- If there are fewer than ten (10) competitors and/or fewer than five (5) countries after the late entry deadline (three (3) competitors and/or two (2) countries for junior classes), the class shall not be run.
- If there are ten (10) or more competitors from five (5) countries after the late entry deadline, but there are effectively fewer than ten (10) competitors and/or fewer than five (5) countries the first day of the competition (three (3) competitors and/or two (2) countries for junior classes), the class will be run and the Champion title will be awarded.
- Champion title shall not be awarded if more than one (1) heat is cancelled in that class.
- RNB-teams will be awarded World Champion titles in all the classes (except Sp4MS and Relay) if minimum ten (10) competitors from five (5) countries are represented

in these classes except in Junior classes where at least three (3) competitors from two (2) countries are represented.

As stated in the IFSS Masters Regulations:

- World Masters titles shall be awarded to the best (fastest) teams of each rated class of the World Masters providing at least seven (7) competitors from three (3) countries are represented in these classes.
- If there are fewer than seven (7) competitors and/or fewer than three (3) countries after the late entry deadline, the class shall not be run.
- If there are seven (7) or more competitors from three (3) countries after the late entry deadline but there are effectively fewer than seven (7) competitors and/or fewer than three (3) countries the first day of the competition, the Master titles will be awarded in that class.

NOMINATIONS:

The IFSS invites gold medal winners from the 2022 IFSS On-Snow World Championships and World Masters, the top three medallists of the Global 2021/2022 World Cup and the winners of the Continental 2021/2022 World Cup to participate in the 2023 IFSS On-Snow World Championships and World Masters as pre-selected participants in their respective classes. The preselected competitors can participate without paying an entry fee.

Each National Voting Member in good standing in IFSS (all dues paid) may enter three (3) participants in each class and two (2) relay teams in addition to its pre-selected participants. The same quota applies for RNB classes and non RNB (Open) classes except for Sp4MS and Relay classes where there is no specific RNB classes. There is no quota for Distance and Masters classes.

Each Provisional Member in good standing in IFSS (all dues paid) may enter one (1) participant in each class and one (1) relay team in addition to its pre-selected participants. The same quota applies for RNB classes and non RNB (Open) classes except for Sp4MS and Relay classes where there is no specific RNB classes. There is no quota for Distance and Masters classes.

All selected participants must hold a valid DID number.

REGISTRATION:

All Registrations and payments (including Relay teams) shall be done according to this schedule:

- All registrations shall be sent to the IFSS VP Sport (sport@sleddogsport.net) with a copy to (treasurer@sleddogsport.net) and IFSS Event coordinator (coordinator@sleddogsport.net).
- The IFSS Entry form must be used (download from IFSS Web site).
- Teams to be seeded, pre-selected teams and Registered Nordic Breed teams shall be marked on the entry form accordingly.
- Entry fees are not refundable, except in the cases mentioned in the IFSS Championships and Masters Regulations.
- Fees for registration and for the DID number CANNOT be combined. Each fee must be paid separately. Please specify the payment in the message.

Feb 6: Ordinary registration

- Registration of the number of qualified drivers, including those who were preselected by IFSS (if possible, register with names and DID number).
- Ordinary entry fees paid for the total number of entries.
- Deadline for additional entry requests. Payment (200% of the regular entry fee) will be made after confirmation of the request has been given.

Feb 13: Registration of late entries (subject to the approval of the IFSS)

- Latest date to register number of qualified drivers.
- All registration and payment received after Feb 6 will be considered late entries.
- All late entries must pay a two hundred percent (200%) entry fee. No late entries will be accepted after Feb 13.

NOTE! After this date no changes of class or more entries will be accepted.

Feb 15: Last day to pay for DID-numbers

- Latest day to pay for the DID-numbers.

Feb 17: Names and DID-numbers

- Latest day to register names and DID-numbers.
- Names and DID-numbers received after Feb 17, will not be accepted.
- Individual names of the relay team members shall be provided to the Race Marshal at the Team Leader meeting on Friday afternoon.

Immediately after Feb 13, the IFSS will notify the concerned Federations if a class is cancelled due to lack of enough participants for World Champion or World Master title (criteria mentioned above).

All competitors must submit an IFSS Competitor Consent Form. For competitors younger than 18 years old on the first day of the competition an IFSS Guardian Form must also be submitted.
